2	Host Job Fair	<p>On March 21, 2017, our SEU hosted “Grand Strands Largest” job fair at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center and participated in this event as a local employer. Our SEU secured the exhibit space, solicited local employers and organized all logistical aspects of the Fair, which attracted approximately 80 businesses/companies. SEU participants included our Promotions Director, Market and Business Managers, and of our Program Directors, who spoke with job seekers about career opportunities in broadcasting as well as job openings and internships within the SEU and accepted applications or resumes from interested attendees.
