1	Hosted On-line Virtual Job Fair	From February 22, 2021 through March 3, 2021 the stations promoted an on-line Brookings Spring Job Fair in conjunction with the South Dakota Career Center. The event also included virtual zoom interview rooms on March 3, 2021 and March 17, 2021. Our SEU solicited local exhibitors, organized logistics, and promoted the event, including airing announcements on the stations. We also participated as a local employer, regarding careers in broadcasting. The on-line fair attracted 30 businesses. Participants included our Sales Manager, General Manager and Programming Director.
